PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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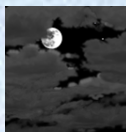
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The big high holds sway for a while longer – but a wave from a low on the boundary between the Southern Ocean and the South Pacific is on the way to disrupt the quiet weather pattern established over the past couple of days. Expect fair weather today and tonight, then deterioration in the form of higher winds and lower visibility in snow starting early tomorrow as it approaches the station.
