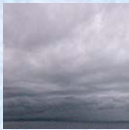
PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

Southward moving lows continue to skip past Anvers Island. Their proximity will determine wind speeds; for now they appear to be passing at far enough of a distance that the resulting winds are generally light. Ditto for snow, though some heavier showers are on tap for tomorrow.
