REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A cooling trend ahead: lows on either side of the peninsula will generate an area of relatively high pressure in between them. After a day & night of intermittent snow showers that high will become the dominant feature tomorrow. Expect breaks in the cloud cover and colder weather to arrive, but light winds mean wind chills will remain reasonable – thus fair weather for this time of year.
