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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Lows continue to track up the peninsula, bringing snow and colder temperatures to Palmer Station. Not far away, however, a strong high pressure center in the South Pacific is slowly drifting eastward. Ridging from this high will become the dominant weather feature at Anvers Island just after this forecast period.
