PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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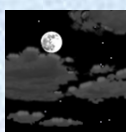
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Temperatures plunge to the lowest of the season this weekend as high pressure moves into the Anvers Island area. Fortunately winds are expected to be mostly light, but wind chills will still approach 0°F overnight as the temperature bottoms out. There's a low approaching that should reverse that trend, but it won't be close enough to make it happen by the end of this forecast period.
