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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

High pressure retreats and the low approaches Palmer Station today, bringing periods of snow and occasionally gusty winds with a northerly component to warm things up a bit. The low is expected to track northward into South America tomorrow, but the pressure gradient in the area will actually tighten due to the influence of a low in the Bellingshausen, resulting in a return of gusty winds.
