PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The low in the Bellingshausen becomes less of an influence on Palmer Station weather today as a high passes through the Drake. Generally calm conditions will prevail overnight tonight, albeit with snow showers throughout. Tomorrow a more powerful low develops to the northwest on the boundary between the South Pacific and the Southern Ocean. The gradient between it and the high will bring strong winds through the day – and even stronger through the night.
