PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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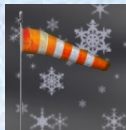
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A complex series of troughs and low pressure centers continues to batter the coast. The worst has passed, and winds will generally be decreasing over the next 24-26 hours – but will remain strong until tomorrow morning, then become light & variable in the afternoon. Temperatures will remain a bit above freezing, so mixed precipitation is possible, but visibility will be lowest in periods of snow.

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 4-6 in mixed precipitation, periods of < 1-2 in snow, blowing snow

Wind (kts): N 30-40 gust 45-55

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -10°C / 14°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 3-5 in snow, periods of < 1-2 in snow, blowing snow

Wind (kts): N-NE 30-40 gust 50 becoming N 20-30

Min Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -10°C / 14°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, periods of 2-4 in snow

Wind (kts): NE 15-20 occasional gust 30 becoming light & variable

Max Temp: 2°C / 35°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F
