REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The pounding relents today as a tightly-wound low passes across the peninsula and into the Weddell Sea, while another weakens to the north of Anvers Island. Snowfall will also diminish; by tomorrow expect fair but colder weather, with winds becoming light & variable under an occasionally blue sky.
