PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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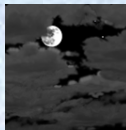
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Weakening low pressure centers will be in the area – but Anvers Island will be in the high pressure area between them, so generally fair weather can be expected through this period. Winds could get a little gusty when those low centers wobble close to Palmer, but not exceedingly. Temperature will fall as cold air moves in with winds from the south, driven in part by one of the previously mentioned lows currently spinning in the Weddell Sea.
