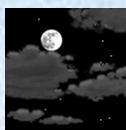
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A strong high pressure ridge moves in from the east, finally kicking out the lingering low clouds and snow that plagued the area yesterday. Fair weather, cold temperatures and partly cloudy skies follow.
