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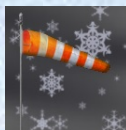
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Tonight a trough extending from a low in the Bellingshausen Sea displaces the ridge currently keeping fair weather in place over Anvers Island. As a result, today's clear and cold becomes cloudy, windy, snowy and cold tonight and tomorrow.
