PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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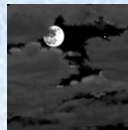
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low passes eastward just to the north of Anvers Island this afternoon through tonight, disrupting an otherwise benign period of weather dominated by high pressure/ridging through the area. But the effects of that low are expected to be minimal; winds a bit gusty and some light snow. Midnight tomorrow night will see a stronger trough approaching, but tomorrow looks to be a fair weather day overall.

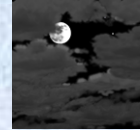
