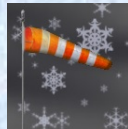
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A large scale low pressure center in the Bellingshausen with troughs and smaller-scale low centers circulating around it will make for interesting weather on Anvers Island to close out the week. Gusty winds, snow, and falling temperatures are all on the way over the next 24-48 hours.
