PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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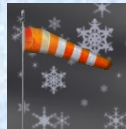
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

No change from yesterday's outlook: lows and troughs pinwheeling around a central low pressure system in the Bellingshausen Sea repeatedly strike Anvers Island from the W-NW, bringing gusty winds and snow of varying intensity to Palmer Station to start the weekend.
