PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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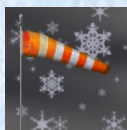
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low circling the central low in the Bellingshausen Sea is heading straight for Anvers Island today; another will follow tomorrow. Gusty winds result, with a peak this morning. Following that the winds will actually be dying through the day today – before gusting back to 50 tomorrow after noon.

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted becoming 3-5 in snow and mist occasionally 1-2

Wind (kts): NE 10-15 becoming NW-NE 30-40 gust 50
