**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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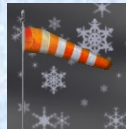
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Prepare for a slightly warmer and significantly windier day today than in the recent past. The major central low to the west is drifting slowly southward, but for today the strong gradient flow around it is aimed squarely at Anvers Island. This means powerful northerly winds bringing snow mixed with rain as a result of the associated warmer air. Winds will slacken as the low drifts back into the Bellingshausen tonight, but smaller lows circulating around it will keep gusty winds and precipitation on Palmer.
