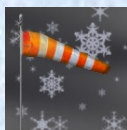
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The low in the Bellingshausen weakens tonight and moves inland tomorrow, resulting in a notable decrease in winds after midnight. But current expectations are for a good battering to occur before then, with hurricane force gusts likely over sustained winds at or near 50 knots. This could likewise deliver the lowest wind chills yet this year, as temperatures will also fall slightly through this event.
