PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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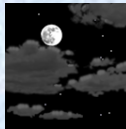
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Flow from around a Weddell Sea low crosses the Peninsula on its way to Anvers Island today, delivering continued colder weather to Palmer Station through this period. Occasional snow persists today, but clearing is expected tonight and tomorrow. After a less breezy next 24 hours the wind picks up again through the day tomorrow as the low intensifies slightly.
