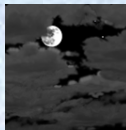
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Ridge today, trough tomorrow – though it will signal its approach with increasing cloudiness this afternoon into evening. Snow should begin early tomorrow morning, then gusty winds will be the last of the party guests to arrive tomorrow around noon or just after. A relatively mild event all around, though, with rising temperatures also along for the ride.

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted

Wind (kts): Variable 8-12

Max Temp: -4°C / 25°F

Min Wind Chill: -13°C / 9°F

Sky: Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming 2-4 in snow

Wind (kts): Light & variable

Min Temp: -6°C / 21°F

Min Wind Chill: -13°C / 9°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted occasionally 2-4 in snow

Wind (kts): Light & variable becoming SW 10-15 gust 25

Max Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -11°C / 12°F
