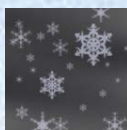
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

There's a bit of lingering snow from the last low left to fall – then a period of high pressure begins. Weather will be fair but cold through much of this period, with winds decreasing with time throughout. Snow will end in the early morning hours tomorrow; some blue sky should be visible thereafter.
