PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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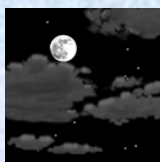
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Mild conditions continue through the period as High pressure remains over the area through today into tonight. Overnight, the High shifts to the eastern side of the Peninsula as a fairly strong Low well to the northwest pushes eastward towards the southern tip of South America, tightening the gradient through the Drake Passage, which in turn will strengthen the winds over the Anvers Island region through Thursday.
