**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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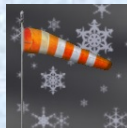
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Expect lulls in the weather, but there will still be strong gusty winds, rain, rain/snow mix, and/or snow, with periods of reduced visibility throughout the forecast period.

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, periods of 4-6 in rain

**Wind (kts):** NW 4-6, becoming NW-NE 10-15 gusting to 20, becoming NE 30-40 gusting to 55

**Max Temp:** 1°C / 34°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -8°C / 18°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, periods of 1-3 in rain, rain/snow mix, snow, and/or mist/fog

**Wind (kts):** NE 30-40 gusting to 55

**Min Temp:** 0°C / 32°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -9°C / 16°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, periods of 1-3 in rain, rain/snow mix, snow, and/or mist/fog

**Wind (kts):** NE 30-40 gusting to 55, NW-NE 18-22 gusting to 30, becoming N-NE 5-10 occasionally gusting to 18

**Max Temp:** 2°C / 36°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -8°C / 18°F
