The low pressure system continues to spins off shore swinging multiple troughs around it. Expect lulls in the weather, but there will still be strong gusty winds, rain, rain/snow mix, and periods of reduced visibility throughout the forecast period.

Sky: Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted with periods of 1-3 in rain, rain/snow mix, and/or mist/fog

Wind (kts): NW-NE 10-15 gusting to 20, becoming NE 25-35 gusting to 50

Max Temp: 4°C / 39°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted with periods of 1-3 in rain, rain/snow mix, snow, and/or mist/fog

Wind (kts): NE 15-25 gusting to 30

Min Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted with periods of 1-3 in rain, rain/snow mix, and/or mist/fog ending late

Wind (kts): NE 15-25 gusting to 30, becoming N-NE 5-10 occasionally gusting to 18

Max Temp: 3°C / 37°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F
