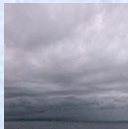

Weak low pressure through this period brings generally light snow showers and moderate winds to Anvers Island and vicinity, but a stronger trough approaching from the west late tomorrow promises heavier snow and gustier winds into the weekend.
