**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

A series of troughs rotating around a strong Southern Ocean low center will hammer the coast throughout this forecast period. Each will be notably stronger than the previous. Expect tropical storm force gusts today to be exceeded by hurricane-force gusts tomorrow, with intermittent heavy mixed precipitation throughout.

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, mixed precipitation, occasional 4-6 in snow showers

**Wind (kts):** SW-NW 15-20, gusts 30

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, occasional 1-3 in snow

**Wind (kts):** N 25-30, gusts increasing to 50 by early morning

**Min Temp:** -2°C / 28°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -11°C / 12°F

**Sky:** Mostly Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, mixed precipitation, occasional 1-3 in snow, blowing snow
