Strong winds this period, with gusts to hurricane force as a series of powerful troughs move through the area. Expect that to drive significant amounts of mixed precipitation in a more horizontal direction than most would prefer, thus lowering visibility and wind chill - the former particularly during periods of heaviest snow. The system should weaken to tropical storm force gusts by evening, but re-intensify a bit tomorrow.
