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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The low center from the north should cross the tip of the peninsula into the Weddell Sea without much impact to Palmer Station today, beyond increasing winds and maybe a spot of snow. A trough approaches from the east tomorrow, promising measurable precipitation but reasonable wind speeds tomorrow night.
