PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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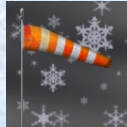
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Prepare for storm-force sustained winds and hurricane gusts on station today, along with a mixture of rain and snow. Although steady decrease in all of that should follow an early peak, it will continue to be windy into tonight, particularly as a second wave delivers additional periods of heavier snow showers commencing around midnight. Expect lingering snow/mixed precipitation and continuing gusty winds (though somewhat diminished) tomorrow as the low responsible weakens slowly in place over the Bellingshausen Sea.

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 4-6 in mixed precipitation occasionally 1-3 in snow, blowing snow

Wind (kts): NE 45-55 gust 65 becoming N-NE 20-30 gust 50

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -11°C / 12°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 3-5 in snow occasionally less than 1 in snow, blowing snow after midnight

Wind (kts): N-NE 20-30 becoming NE 25-35 gust 45 after midnight

Min Temp: -1°C / 30°F

Min Wind Chill: -10°C / 14°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 4-6 in mixed precipitation occasionally 1-3 in snow, blowing snow

Wind (kts): NE 25-35 becoming N-NE 15-25

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F
