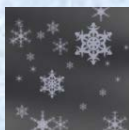
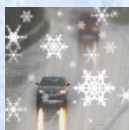
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A cold front will move quickly east through Palmer today, preceded by milder temperatures from brisk north winds this morning. Rain and/or snow is likely this morning, changing to all snow later this afternoon. Another cold front will approach from the west on Monday. This system appears stronger, and will likely be accompanied by strong NE winds all day Monday. After a lull in the snow later tonight and early Monday, snow will return Monday afternoon and evening.

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 4-6 in rain and/or snow, with occasional 1-3 in rain and/or snow. 1-3 in snow this afternoon.

**Wind (kts):** N 15-25 gusts to 35, becoming NW 10-15 this afternoon

**Max Temp:** 2°C / 36°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -8°C / 18°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 1-3 in snow, becoming unrestricted with a few flurries possible after midnight

**Wind (kts):** NW 5-15, becoming N-NE 15-30 late

**Min Temp:** -1°C / 30°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -9°C / 17°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted with a few flurries early, becoming 1-3 in snow late

**Wind (kts):** NE 30-40 gusts to 50

**Max Temp:** 1°C / 34°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -10°C / 15°F
