PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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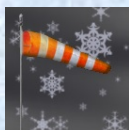
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The center of a broad, deep low pressure system remains in place west of the peninsula. Disturbances rotating around this low will continue to pound the Anvers Island area with hurricane-force wind gusts and driving snow today, weakening to storm-force gusts overnight and tomorrow.
