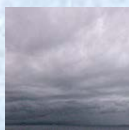
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low departs the area today and tonight, but an even stronger low is on its way from the west, and will start to make its presence known later tomorrow in the form of high winds and heavy snow. Temperatures (and wind chill) will continue remain a degree or 2 below recent average, but begin to warm late in this period.
