REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Continued northwesterly onshore flow delivers fresh waves of snow to Palmer Station today. Precipitation halts overnight and most of tomorrow, but will return late in this forecast period. The low center responsible is actually far to the west, and heading on shore into Marie Byrd Land, but is deep and powerful enough to keep gusty conditions in place through the peninsula region into the weekend.

Sky: Cloudy becoming Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 4-6 in mixed precipitation, occasional 1-3 in snow

Wind (kts): NW 15-20 occasional gust 30

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Sky: Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional snow

Wind (kts): N 15-20 gust 30

Min Temp: -1°C / 30°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted becoming 4-6 in snow

Wind (kts): NE 15-20 gust 30 becoming 25-35 gust 45

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -10°C / 14°F
