PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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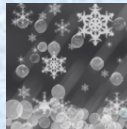
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

More waves of precipitation and wind delivered by passing low pressure systems today, then a brief break for a high pressure ridge passing through before the strongest low center of recent days approaches late tomorrow. Gusts to near hurricane force are likely as that one nears Anvers Island tomorrow night through early Monday.

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally 1-2 in mixed precipitation early

Wind (kts): NE-SE 25-35 gust 40 becoming N-NE 15-20

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally 4-6 in mixed precipitation, lower early

Wind (kts): NE 15-20

Visibility (SM): 4-6 in mixed precipitation occasionally 1-2 in snow

Wind (kts): NW 15-25 becoming NE 40-45 gust 60 late

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -12°C / 10°F
