REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The general flow pattern in the area has oriented north-to-south, between a low pressure center to the northwest and a high to the northeast. Troughs propagating southward within this atmospheric flow will bring warm air along with waves of precipitation and occasionally gusty winds across the southern Drake to Anvers Island and the peninsula beyond.
