PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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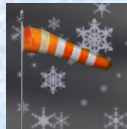
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The general flow pattern remains the same: north-to-south, low pressure to the west, high to the east. Troughs propagating southward within this atmospheric flow will generate waves of precipitation and gusty surface winds alternating with fair weather on and around Anvers Island throughout this forecast period. Temperatures will remain relatively warm. Winds will peak at around 50 knots tomorrow.
