PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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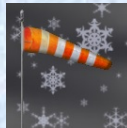
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Today: gusty but mostly dry; tonight: gusty with mixed precipitation; tomorrow: lighter winds, heavier snow. It's all from one last trough traveling southward across the Drake, after which the flow pattern that has generated the Anvers Island weather over the past few days will shift to a more typical one of passing low centers periodically stirring things up along the northern peninsula.
