REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Snow continues, with a likely break tomorrow morning into the early afternoon, when that slow-moving low center at last passes through Palmer on its way north. Light winds with a significant southerly component in its wake will ensure temperatures remain on the cold side. A weaker low trailing the first will bring additional snow near the end of this period.
