**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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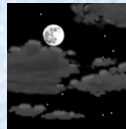
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

The last of the low pressure waves finally passes on by, and a ridge becomes the dominant weather maker for Anvers Island and Palmer Station. Drier conditions and at least partially blue skies are likely today and tomorrow, but a relatively cloud-free night tonight will contribute to colder temperatures expected to remain at least through this next 48 hours.
