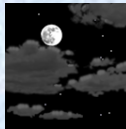
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

The ridge continues to dominate. Cold and dry conditions will ultimately prevail after a period of patchy morning fog today. Winds will be periodically gusty overnight until tomorrow in response to small scale pressure centers moving through the area.
