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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

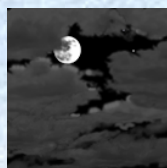
The current weather pattern features rapid movement of systems from west to east. A cool high pressure ridge will build across the Antarctic Peninsula today and tonight. A warming trend will commence late Saturday night, as a warm front approaches from the northwest. Once the snow ends early today, fair weather is expected until Saturday, as winds and snow increase ahead of the warm front.

Sky: Cloudy, becoming partly cloudy in the afternoon

Visibility (SM): 1-2 in snow early, becoming unrestricted with flurries

Wind (kts): SW-W 20-25 gusts to 35, becoming 15-20 late afternoon

Max Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 15°F

Sky: Mostly cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted with flurries

Wind (kts): W 12-16, becoming N-NE 10-20 late

Min Temp: -4°C / 25°F

Min Wind Chill: -13°C / 9°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted with flurries, becoming 1-2 in snow in the afternoon

Wind (kts): N 25-35 gusts to 45

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -10°C / 14°F
