Relatively cool, moist west to northwest flow will help maintain periods of snow and fog through tomorrow morning. Fair weather is expected to develop tomorrow afternoon, as a weak high pressure ridge builds across the southern Antarctic Peninsula.

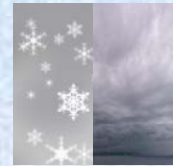
