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## **REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

A broad, intensifying low pressure system will move from the Southern Ocean this morning into the Bellingshausen Sea this evening. Strong northerly flow ahead of this system will bring a relatively mild, moist airmass to Palmer. Small, difficult-to-time disturbances rotating around this low will occasionally enhance winds and precipitation, with a lull in wind and precipitation expected later this morning through about mid afternoon.
