PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

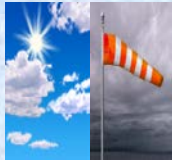
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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Today should start fair and breezy with increasing clouds, wind and temperatures this afternoon. Expect a double-whammy as the initial frontal boundary off broad low pressure to the west crashes the peninsula this evening with high wind and scattered rain showers, and a second wave hot on its heels tomorrow morning bringing periods of heavier precipitation turning to mixed-to-snow by evening...

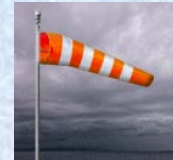

Sky: Partly Cloudy becoming Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted

Wind (kts): NW-NE 12-22, increasing to NE-SE 30-45 by evening

Max Temp: 5°C / 41°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional 2-4 rain showers

Wind (kts): NE-SE 30-45, becoming N-NE 20-30

Min Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -6°C / 21°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 2-4 rain showers, occasional Unrestricted; chance of snow, rain/snow mixed by evening

Wind (kts): N-NE 20-30, becoming NE 30-45, becoming NW 25-35; easing overnight

Max Temp: 3C / 37°F

Min Wind Chill: -7°C / 19°F
