#### REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The weather pattern at Palmer will be prone to quick changes the next few days, as a series of low pressure troughs and high pressure ridges rotate rapidly around a broad cyclone centered over the Bellingshausen Sea. A cold front will move through Palmer this morning, followed by a weak ridge later today through early Saturday. The next cold front will approach from the west late tomorrow.
