Deepening low pressure is approaching from the northwest today, bringing strong winds and snow with it. Improved but still cloudy conditions expected overnight, but it appears tomorrow will be a slightly more intense version of today as another low hits the area.

Visibility (SM): 1-3 in snow, becoming Unrestricted

Wind (kts): E 20-30, becoming N 8-12

Min Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F

Sky: Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming 1-3 in snow

Wind (kts): N 8-12, becoming NE 20-30, gusts to 40

Max Temp: -1°C / 30°F
