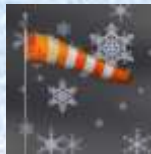
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Mild conditions continue through about midday today under a passing ridge of high pressure. Strong northerly winds and a mix of rain and snow are expected to begin this afternoon as a strong frontal system slams into the Peninsula. There may be periods overnight where the precipitation is all snow, which at times could be fairly heavy.
