REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A cold front will move east across the Antarctic Peninsula this morning, accompanied by breezy and snowy conditions. The high temperature will occur this morning. A brief lull in wind speed and precipitation is likely later tonight or early Saturday, followed by increasing winds and snow on Saturday, as a modest warm front approaches Palmer from the west.

Wind (kts): W-NW 10-15

Min Temp: -4°C / 25°F

Min Wind Chill: -11°C / 12°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted early, becoming 3-5 with occasional 1-2 in snow

Wind (kts): NW 10-15 early, becoming NW-N 15-25 with gusts to 35

Max Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -10°C / 15°F
