The remains of low pressure pushes east across the area today keeping skies cloudy with varying visibility in light snow and fog. Skies should break this evening as transient high pressure moves in from west. A warm frontal boundary should pass early tomorrow morning off broad low pressure wheeling into Drake's Passage...

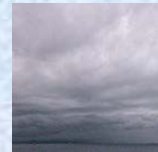

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally 2-4 light snow, fog

Wind (kts): SW-W 5-10, becoming W 12-25

Max Temp: -1°C / 30°F

Min Wind Chill: -11°C / 12°F

Sky: Mostly Cloudy to Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional light snow early morning

Wind (kts): NW-N 10-20, becoming N-NE 17-32

Min Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -11°C / 12°F

Sky: Cloudy, occasionally Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional light snow early morning

Wind (kts): NW-NE 12-22, becoming NE 8-18

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -10°C / 14°F
