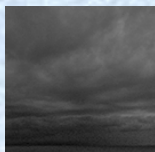
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Broad low pressure wheeling east through Drake's Passage will push a warm front across the area today from the northwest. Expect cloudy and breezy conditions, and possibly some rain mixing with snow. Wind speeds ease overnight through tomorrow as high pressure builds in from the west.

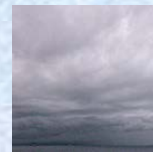
